AVAILABILITY

Same as the specific rate incorporating this adjustment by reference.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable as a modification of each rate schedule of the Utility in which reference is made to Rate "ECA".

MONTHLY RATE

The current monthly bill, as calculated under any rate schedule subject to this Rate "ECA", shall be increased or decreased by the amount equal to the product of the kilowatt-hours used times the current month's energy (purchased power) cost adjustment factor per kilowatt-hour.

The energy (purchased power) cost adjustment factor to be applied monthly to each kilowatt-hour sold by the Utility subject to the Rate "ECA" shall be calculated in accordance with the following formulas:

FOR ALL APPLICABLE SERVICES:

$$ECA = \underline{PC} - BASE$$

TE

WHERE:

- ECA = Energy cost adjustment factor to be applied to the retail kilowatt-hour sales to which this Rate "ECA" is applicable during the current billing month and computed to the nearest one-thousandth of a mill per kilowatt-hour.
- PC = Power costs in dollars from all power supply sources for the last 3 months, including: purchased power cost and, fuel charges and true-up costs, if applicable; and, rental cost of generators to meet system load requirements and, fuel, operation and maintenance cost of generators.
- TE = Total energy from all power supply sources for the last 3 months.
- BASE = Base value per kilowatt-hour as last established by the Board of Directors.

GENERAL

Rate "ECA" supercedes and rescinds Rate "ECA", Revised Sheet No. 8, with an effective date of January 1, 2007, and therefore will apply to all billing for retail electric service rendered on or after October 1, 2008, and shall continue from month to month until rescinded.
